The update from 7/16/14 is as follows: one officer was added and I took one officer off the list, so there are still 14 officers on the list. Of those 14, 4 are currently employed in Cheshire County as sworn law enforcement officers. I cannot tell you what happened to the other 10 officers other than to say they are not working as law enforcement officers in Cheshire County. The vast majority of the officers placed on the list pre-date my tenure as County Attorney, so I cannot provide you with the additional details you requested.

Pursuant to the laws of New Hampshire, you are asked to review the personnel files of your policy agency to determine if you possess any information that might be discoverable pursuant to *Sate v. Laurie*, 139 NH 325 (1995). This review is essential to comply with the legal duties placed on the State.

If you determine that you possess such information, you must notify the county attorney's office by filling out the attached "Sample Notification Form." You may recognize that the form is the same as that contained in the New Hampshire Department of Justice memorandum dated February 18, 2004. Please disclose the information even if you believe that the Office of the Grafton County Attorney already has it. I have enclosed the most recent Attorney General's memorandum regarding identifying *Laurie* issues. Please be advised that the Attorney General's Office has expressly modified one provision in their memorandum. *Laurie* issues no longer lapse after ten years.

Kindly respond to the above requests by September 15, 2014 and please let us know if this date causes you any difficulty. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

Dear Ms. West:

This is in response to your recent Right to Know request. You have requested via an e-mail "for purposes of inspection and photocopying, the current version of any and all 'Laurie' lists maintained by your office." You have also requested "any and all e-mails between your office and any other individual, agency, or department relative to Laurie or exculpatory evidence dating back to 2012." Lastly you requested me to include "whether any names have been added that were previously deleted and whether or not the individual on the list is still working in law enforcement."

Right to Know requests are designed to provide copies of documents or reports in the possession of the government that are not privileged. As we have discussed in the past, I do not have a "Laurie" report that I can share with you because of the statutory protection afforded law enforcement personnel files.

Since 2004, County Attorneys have been required to keep lists of county law enforcement officers that are identified as potentially having "Laurie" issues. New Hampshire law has supplemented the 2004 Laurie memorandum issued by the New Hampshire Department of Justice, which has been modified.

I can provide the following information: Grafton County has three individuals currently serving as law enforcement officers who the court has found to have a Laurie issue. This information has been, and will continue to be, disclosed to defense in accordance to the court orders. There are six additional individuals currently serving as members of the law enforcement community who have been reported to me under the criteria set forth in the attached memorandum issued by the Office of the Attorney General. If they become a witness in a case in this court, I will ask the Court to review their personnel file. The Court would then determine whether there is a Laurie issue that needs to be disclosed. The Grafton County Superior Court has been clear in prior orders that it will not review these files until the State can represent that the officer is a potential witness in a pending matter. The Office of the Grafton County Attorney

would recommend a process whereby files of any currently serving member of law enforcement could be reviewed by the Court, even if there is not a pending criminal matter in court.

I have a list with the names of six other individuals who are no longer working as officers, who have had *Laurie* issues identified by the court. There are six more individuals, who are no longer working as officers, who were reported by his or her Chief(s) as having engaged in conduct that necessitates review of their personnel file by the Court pursuant to the guidelines set forth by the New Hampshire Superior Court, New Hampshire legislature and/or the memorandum. Because these individuals are no longer members of law enforcement and have no pending cases, I do not anticipate the court having the opportunity to review these referrals.

I am not including members of law enforcement who serve as a New Hampshire State Trooper or for the Division of Liquor Enforcement. Also, if a superior court judge reviewed a file and noted there was not a "Laurie" issue, I am not including that officer's name. I do have a list of those individuals, along with the court order.


In addition, I am not able to identify the town(s) of these individuals, as many departments are so small, identifying the town could identify the individual. Likewise, if I report who does not have *Laurie* issues I would then be, by exclusion, identifying agencies with *Laurie* issues.

In the past, I have provided you with a copy of the Office of the New Hampshire Attorney General's memorandum, and the New Hampshire Supreme Court decision *State v. Laurie*. I believe you are also familiar with New Hampshire laws related to this matter.

I am attaching a recent request for updated lists forwarded to Grafton County police departments. I re sent it to remind agencies who had not sent confirmation. I am not attaching the written responses, but the data is disclosed above. Disclosing the actual document would be inappropriate as essentially disclosing personnel information.

I hope this is of assistance. If you have any additional questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.

Dear Ms. West:

This is a response to your email of this date in which you request access to "Laurie" lists maintained by this Office. I have attached a redacted list which was printed out from the database we maintain of officers who have *potential* exculpatory evidence in their personnel files. This is NOT a list of police officers who have lied or falsified evidence. It is merely a mechanism in which prosecutors are able to abide by their ethical duties to ensure fairness in the criminal justice system.

Please note I have placed an asterisk next to the department that currently employs one of the persons named on the list. I have also noted the officers who are on the list for 'excessive use of force'. Pursuant to caselaw, these officers' personnel files would only be provided for review if they were to testify in a case where there may be an allegation of force used by police or the defendant, ie, Resisting Arrest.

As you know, any information which is contained in a police officer's personnel file is confidential pursuant to RSA 105:13-b. I do not have access to the personnel files of ANY police officer and cannot provide you with any additional information, nor provide access to the files themselves.

I have, from time to time, obtained copies of other Laurie lists in the course of working on conflict cases. Those lists are not retained after those cases are adjudicated and I currently have no such list in my possession.
